Mayor C. Burghardt-Jesson called the meeting to order at 10:00 am

## Declaration of Pecuniary Interest & Nature Thereof

Mayor C. Burghardt-Jesson advised that Dr. Chris Mackie, Medical Officer of Health issued an instruction on Friday, July 17<sup>th</sup>, under the *Emergency Management and Civil Protection Act* (EMCPA) that mandates the requirement of face masks in all indoor spaces that are publicly accessible. She further noted that along with Dr. Mackie's instructions he also suggested that municipalities within the Middlesex London Health Unit district pass a by-law that would mirror his orders or a resolution of support of his instruction. Discussion took place regarding the draft by-law included, enforcement, education and awareness for our local businesses, the readiness and availability of masks for businesses and citizens and the possibility of the province lifting the Declaration of Emergency next week. R. Reymer noted that the By-Law will become effective after passing and expires on December 31, 2020.
